

## WHAT THE FUTURE LOOKS LIKE

### A depoliticized military

- No ideology
- No regime loyalty
- Loyalty only to the nation and constitution

### Civilian control

- Military does not govern
- Transparent oversight and accountability

### Secure borders, stable region

- Active border protection
- Prevention of terrorism and cross-border destabilization

## WHY THIS MATTERS FOR EUROPE

A stable Iran means:

- Less risk of regional war
- Lower migration pressure
- Reduced terrorism and trafficking networks
- A reliable partner instead of a source of instability

**The core message**

**No dictatorship.**

**No chaos.**

**No revenge.**

**Security, justice, and a democratic transition.**

## WHAT THIS PLAN GUARANTEES

No security vacuum

- Immediate protection of borders, cities, and infrastructure
- Prevention of militias, sabotage, and armed unrest
- Continuity of police, army, and essential services

### No blind revenge or mass purges

- Lessons learned from Iran 1979 and Iraq 2003
- Case-by-case vetting – not collective punishment
- Stability prioritized over emotional retaliation

### Justice – not impunity

- Prosecution of those responsible for torture, killings, and corruption
- Legal accountability through courts – not mob violence

## WHAT WILL CHANGE IMMEDIATELY

### End of repressive structures

- IRGC, Basij, Quds Force → dissolved
- Morality Police → abolished
- Parallel intelligence networks → dismantled

### Creation of a unified national system

- One professional military
- One accountable intelligence service
- One civilian-controlled police system

Europeans ask one key question:

Will Iran collapse into chaos after the regime falls?

Short answer: No – if there is a plan.
